- AUPE will increase its annual sponsorship of the Parkland institute from \$15,000 to \$20,000
- \$20,000 will be donated to the greater Edmonton Alliance with the expectation that they will assist with the change the Labour law campaign
- \$10,000 will be donated to Public interest Alberta also with a request to help with the change the labour law campaign

- The Anti –priv committee will be producing a CD At a cost of \$30,000 to promote the anti priv committees mandate
- The Grandparents day picnic will be held in Edmonton on the legislature grounds and other locations around the province where practical.
